Dear Higher Community,

It has been my honor and privilege to lead The Higher Foundation since inception in 2018 to today in 2024. The upcoming 2024-25 Academic Year will be our 6th year serving Georgia college students, helping them to go higher in their education and career by removing post-secondary educational attainment barriers from their paths. In this 6th year, we are increasing our impact by awarding \$50,000 in 80 grants and 10 scholarships to serve 90 Georgia college students. To do this, we need our Higher Community's support through The 2024 Give Higher Campaign.

The 2024 Give Higher Campaign is our annual grassroots fundraising campaign that raises funds for our grants and scholarships. Need-Based Aid

The Higher Foundation Grant promotes post-secondary education by providing need-based financial aid to Georgia college students. We award grants directly to Georgia college students to help cover their cost of attendance expenses such as: Food, Transportation, Housing, Healthcare, Career Advancement, and Higher Education.

Merit-Based Aid

The Higher Foundation Scholarship promotes post-secondary education by providing merit-based financial aid to Georgia college students. We select Higher Scholars based on the strength of their academic background, campus & community involvement, leadership skills, and professional development.

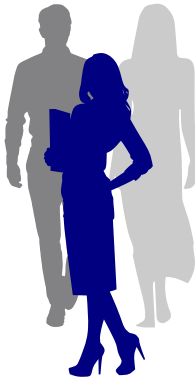

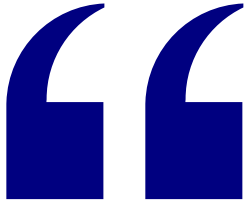

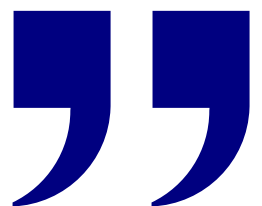

CAMPAIGN GOALS

80 Grants

For the 2024-25 Academic Year, we will award 80 grants at \$500 each for \$40,000 total. We will award 40 grants in the Fall 2024 semester and 40 grants in the Spring 2025 semester. These grants will provide need-based aid to 80 Georgia college students, helping them to overcome financial strain and go higher in their education and career. 10 Scholarships

For the 2024-25 Academic Year, we will award 10 scholarships at \$1,000 each for \$10,000 total. We will award 5 scholarships in the Fall 2024 semester and 5 scholarships in the Spring 2025 semester. These scholarships will provide merit-based aid to 10 Georgia college students, helping them to overcome financial strain and go higher in their education and career. 90 Students

For the 2024-25 Academic Year, we will award 80 need-based grants at \$40,000 total and 10 merit-based scholarships at \$10,000 total to impact 90 Georgia college students. **To do this, we must meet The 2024 Give Higher Campaign Goal of \$50,000.** We want to meet our half-way mark of \$25,000 by August 1st, 2024 to fund our Fall 2024 services, and we want to meet our final fundraising goal of \$50,000 by December 1st, 2024 to fund our Spring 2025 services. Together, we can do it!
